

GRAVE DECORATION RULES & REGULATIONS

- › Only fresh natural floral bouquets in approved containers will be permitted from April 1st until October 31st.
- › Flags, potted plants and artificial flowers are permitted one week before Memorial Day and are to be removed by the weekend following Memorial Day.
- › Wreaths and artificial flowers will be permitted after November 1st. They will be removed during spring cleanup starting March 15th.
- › Flower beds may be planted by upright monuments only. They must stay within 18 inches of the monument base and within the property lines of the owner. If flower beds must be removed when making an interment, the cemetery association is not responsible for replacement.

SINGLE GRAVES

- › One marker only shall be set at each grave on a lot or in the single grave section.

MONUMENT LOT

- › One monument only will be permitted on any lot, sold as a monument lot, and must be placed upon the space designated for the same when the lot was platted.

These rules and regulations are for the purpose of maintaining and preserving the dignity and attractive natural appearance of the cemetery.
